Statutory Duty.

As a local authority leading and speaking on behalf of the community, the council will play its part in making society fairer by tackling discrimination and providing equality of opportunities for all. The Equality Act places a duty on the council to work to:

- Eliminate discrimination, harassment, victimisation and any other contact prohibited under the Act.
- Advance equality of opportunity between persons who share a protected characteristic and persons who do not. Foster good relations between persons who share a protected characteristicand persons who do not.
- NO individual will be unjustifiably discriminated against. This includes but is not limited to the following (known as protected under the Equalities Act.)

Age, Disability - Gender reassignment - Marriage and Civil Partnerships - Pregnancy and Maternity - Race - Religion and Beliefs - Sex - Sexual Orientation.
